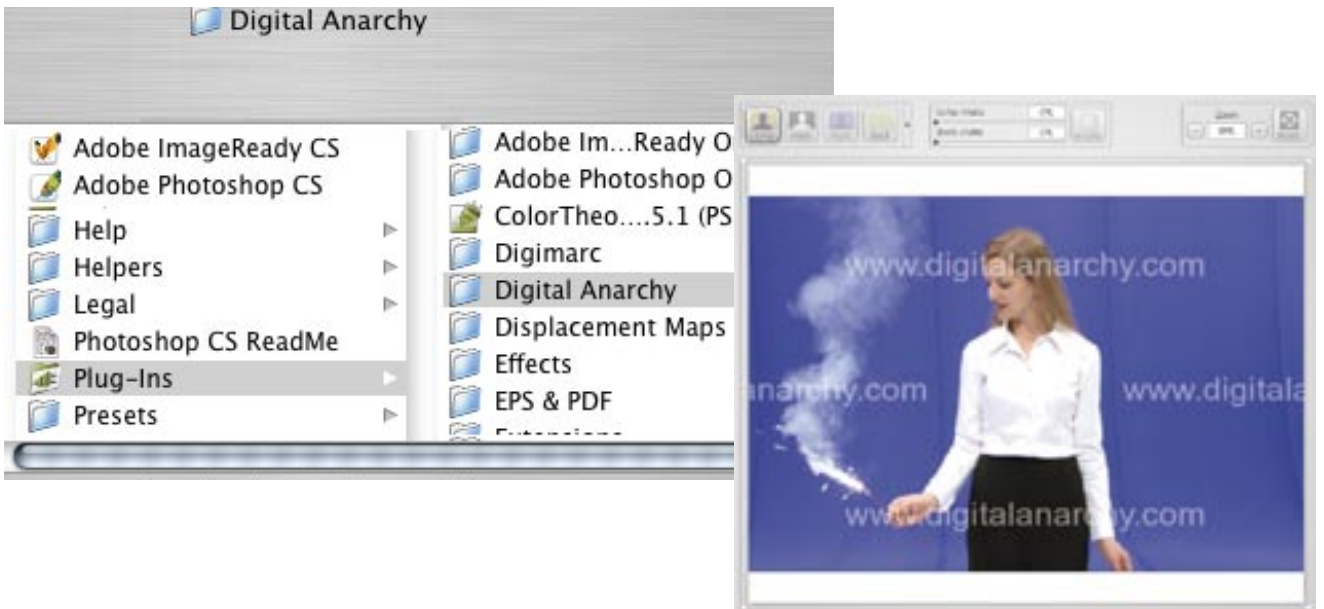


# install a Photoshop demo for Mac OS

---

A basic step-by-step to install your product demo on a Macintosh computer.



**please note :** This installation guide uses the Texture Anarchy plugin set as an example. However, the instructions relate to all Photoshop plugins from Digital Anarchy.

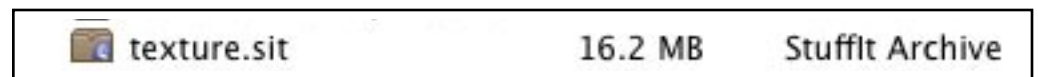


To install your demo, you will first decompress the installation file. Then you will run the installer, click a few buttons, and designate the location for the demo files to go. After a quick registration, you're ready to try out the plugin!

## 01- unstuff the file

If you downloaded the installer, it was delivered to you in a .SIT file. You will first need to uncompress the file.

A .SIT file is a file that holds another file, like a tupperware container for digital files. It compresses the file, which makes delivery across the internet easier. [ figure 1 ]



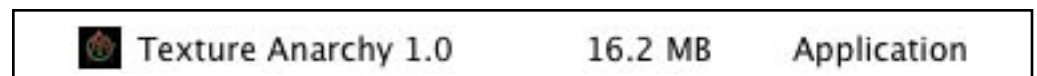

Typically, you can double-click the .SIT file to extract the installer. Your computer should have the free utility that automatically launches to open the .SIT file. This utility is called UnStuffit, and is available at [www.aladdinsys.com](http://www.aladdinsys.com).

**Please note:** If you received the demo file on a CD, the installer file is NOT compressed. Therefore, you can skip to Step 02.

## 02- open the installer

The installer is a file without an visible extension. Its file type is 'Application'. [ figure 2 ]

Now double-click the installer file to launch it. The next steps explain what you do inside the installer.

## 03- license agreement

Click the 'Accept' button to accept the License Agreement. If you don't accept the License, the installer will not continue!

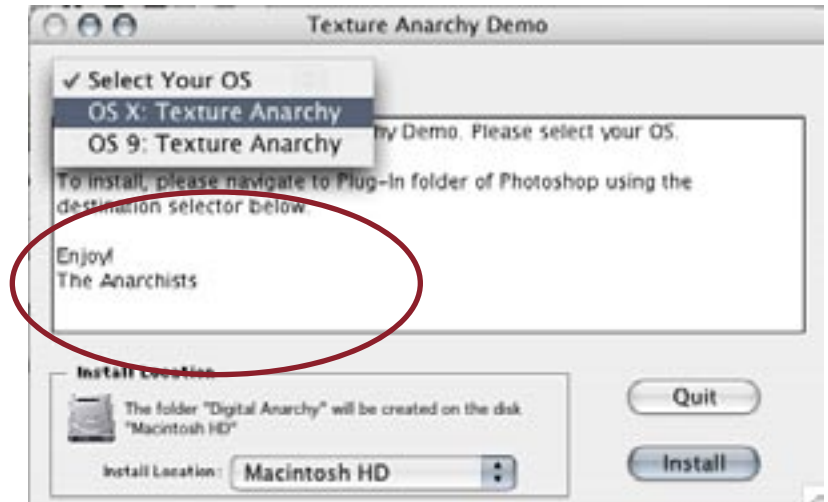


## 04- choose your OS

The next screen has two areas that need to be addressed. First, you need to 'Select Your OS' at the top left of the screen. [ figure 3 ]

If you are installing for OS X, then choose that OS. If you are installing for OS 9, well, you choose OS 9.

**Please note:** You must be running in the OS that you are installing for. If you plan to use this plugin under multiple OS's, then you must install twice, each time while in that OS.



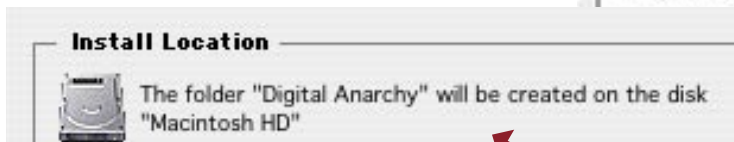

## 05- check the install location

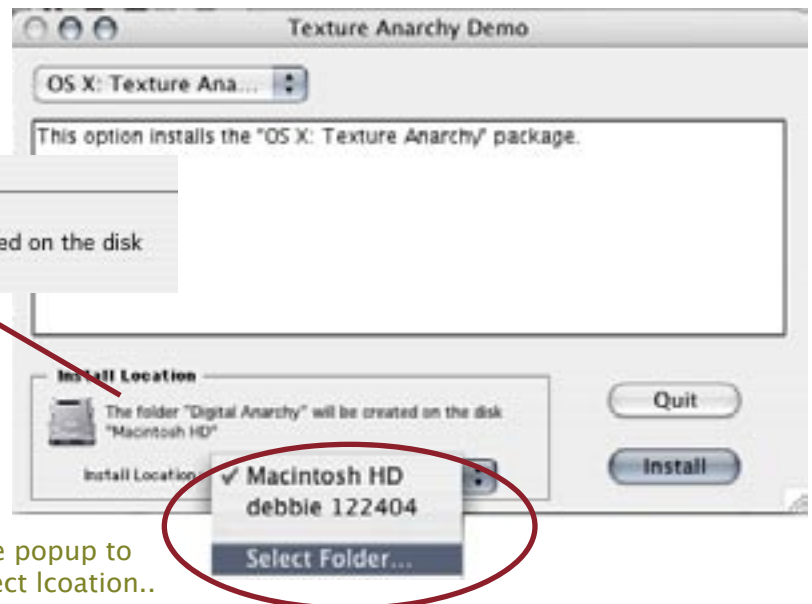
You need to install the demo file into the Photoshop 'Plug-ins' folder on your hard drive. This allows Photoshop to see the plugin.

If the 'Install Location' is NOT pointing to the 'Plug-ins' folder, the path will not mention 'Photoshp' or 'Plug-ins'. [ figure 4 ]

Please click the 'Install Location' popup to navigate there. [ figure 5 ]

[ figure 5 ] Click the popup to browse for the correct location..

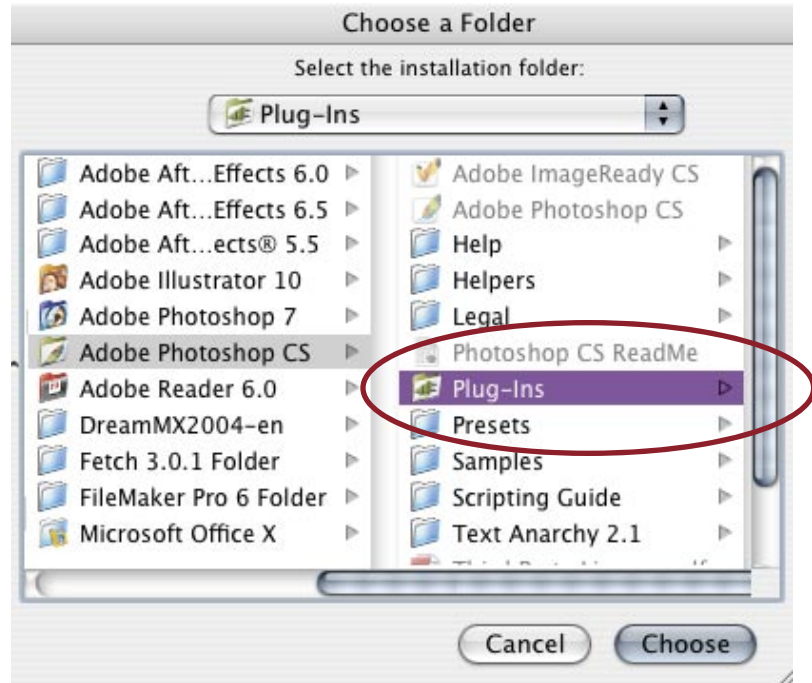


## 06- navigate to 'plug-ins' folder

A dialog box will open. Use this box to navigate to your Photoshop 'Plugins' folder. [ figure 6 ]

Hit the 'Choose' button once you're in the correct location.

**Please note:** You cannot install the plugin into two Photoshop application folders during the installation process. If you plan to install into two or more versions of Photoshop, you will need to run the installer again.



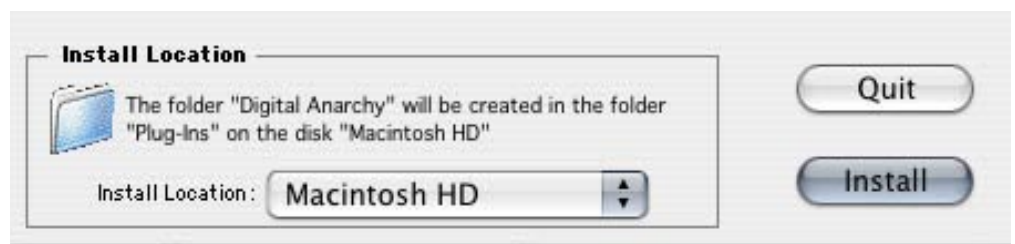

## 07- install the demo

Back in the main installer window, your install location should read something like this:

**The folder 'Digital Anarchy' will be created in the folder 'Plug-ins' on the disk 'Macintosh HD'.**

This path indicates that a folder named 'Digital Anarchy' (that's our company!) will be created inside the 'Plug-ins' folder. The demo will be installed inside that folder. [ figure 7 ]

## 08- click to install

Now click the 'Install' button to begin installation.

## 09- register your usage online

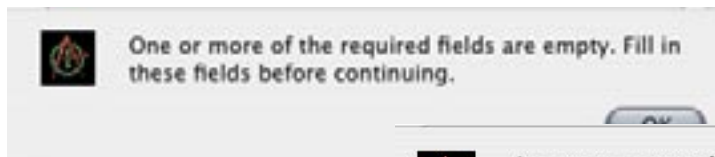
You will be asked to register the use of this demo. We use your info to help us figure out who is using our product, and in what countries. [ figure 8 ]

You'll receive an error message if you leave these fields blank. [ figure 9 ]

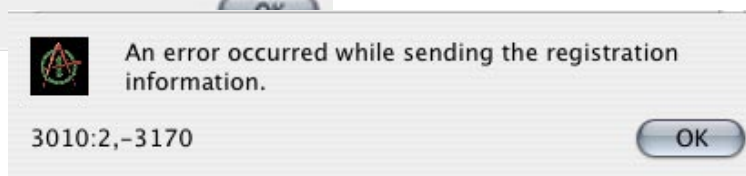
You may receive an error message if you are on a computer that's not online. Just click the 'OK' button. Your installation will still be successful. [ figure 10 ]

## 10- confirm internet settings

Generally, you can click past the next message that appears, as it doesn't apply to most people. Hit the 'Continue' button to finish installation. [ figure 11 ]

## 11- installer message

If you receive a message that '**No installation was necessary**', don't panic! This simply says that you have already installed the plugins, and the installer detected those files on your hard drive. [ figure 12 ]

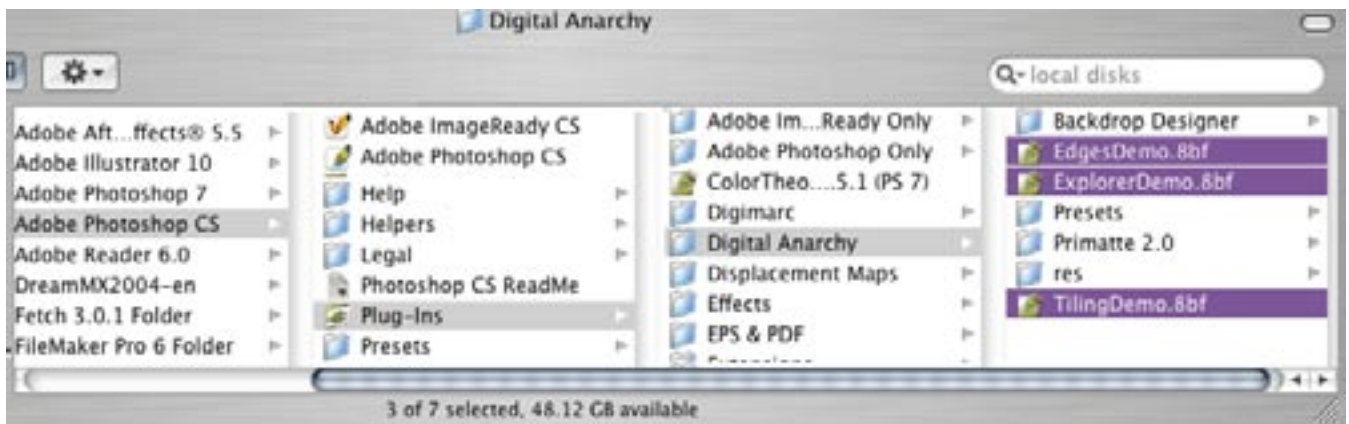




## 12- where are the plugin files?

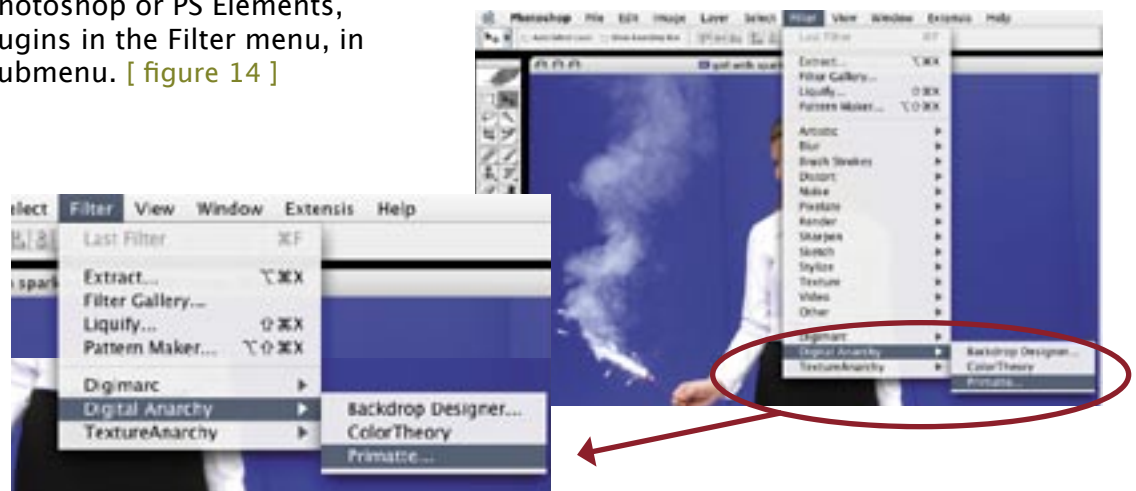


[ figure 13 ]

If you want to check where the plugins went, just look on your hard drive in the Photoshop 'Plug-ins' folder. [ figure 13 ]

Notice that a directory called 'Digital Anarchy' (that's our company!) has been created inside the 'Plug-ins' folder. The demo files are installed inside that directory.

## 13- where are they in photoshop?

When you launch Photoshop or PS Elements, you will find our plugins in the Filter menu, in a Digital Anarchy submenu. [ figure 14 ]

Our plugins are accessed through the Photoshop> Filter> Digital Anarchy menu.



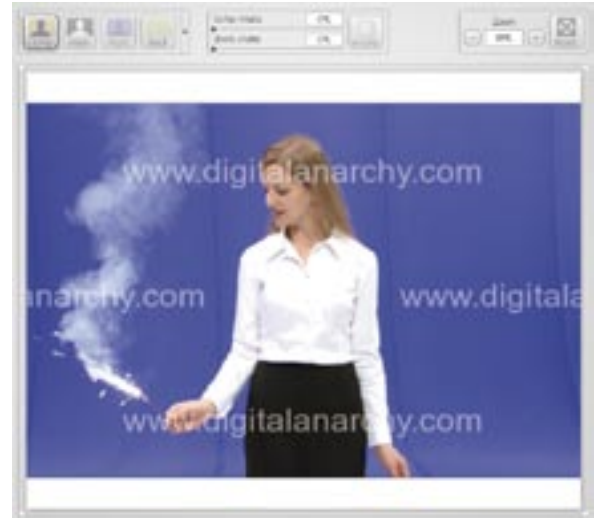


#### 14- how does the demo work?

The product demo is fully functional and non-expiring. Every tool and action that you can take in the purchased version are present in the trial version.

This allows you to completely evaluate a Digital Anarchy product before you buy it.

However, the image you work on will be watermarked. This means that a big red 'X' or our company name will stamped across the final output, making the magery unusable. [ figure 15 ]
